Accommodations:

--Rooms in the Tapa Tower will be \$185 per night (plus tax) for a partial ocean view room for 2 people (Up to 4 people can stay in one room for a \$50 each per day additional fee for person #3 and #4) and children under 18 are free.

--This special rate will be available for 3 nights before and after the training dates.

--Rooms include: King bed or two Double beds; High-speed Internet access (extra charge); Refrigerator; Roll-away bed on request and based on availability (extra charge).
